REGIONAL DISTRICT OF NORTH OKANAGAN

BYLAW No. 2151

(Consolidated for Convenience Only – Refer to Original Bylaw)

A bylaw to establish a local area grant service for the Okanagan Film Commission in the Regional District of North Okanagan

WHEREAS Section 796(1) [General authority for services] of the Local Government Act, R.S.B.C., 1996, Chapter 323, as amended, and Regulations passed pursuant thereto, states that the Board of the Regional District of North Okanagan may operate any service that the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the regional district;

AND WHEREAS Sections 796 [General authority for services] and 800 [Establishing bylaws required for most services] of the Local Government Act provides for the adoption of a bylaw to establish a new Regional District service;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to establish a local area grant service for the Okanagan Film Commission in the Regional District of North Okanagan which includes all of the City of Armstrong, District of Coldstream, Village of Lumby, and City of Vernon; (Bylaw 2482/11)²

AND WHEREAS the Board has, by resolution, determined that the approval process shall be by consent of the member municipalities in accordance with Section 801.4 [Consent on behalf of municipal participating area] of the Local Government Act;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of the Regional District of North Okanagan, in open meeting assembled hereby, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Okanagan Film Commission Grant Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2151, 2006".

ESTABLISHMENT OF SERVICE

- 2. The local area grant service for the Okanagan Film Commission called the 'Okanagan Film Commission Service' is hereby established. (Bylaw 2302/08)¹
- The Regional District is hereby authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the provision of grants a local service for the Okanagan Film Commission. (Bylaw 2302/08)¹

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

4. The service established by this Bylaw is limited to the provision of a grant local service for the Okanagan Film Commission. (Bylaw 2302/08)¹

ESTABLISHMENT OF SERVICE AREA

5. The boundaries of the local area service include all of the City of Armstrong, District of Coldstream, Village of Lumby, and City of Vernon within the Regional District of North Okanagan. (Bylaw 2482/11)²

PARTICIPANTS

6. The participants of this service are the City of Armstrong, District of Coldstream, Village of Lumby, and City of Vernon. (Bylaw 2482/11) ²

COST RECOVERY

- 7. The annual cost of providing the local area service outlined in this Bylaw shall be recovered by any combination of the following:
 - a. requisition of money under Sections 805 [Requisition of funds from municipalities] of the Local Government Act to be collected by a property value tax to be levied and collected under Section 805.1 [Collection in municipalities] of the said Act.
 - b. fees and charges imposed under section 363 [Imposition of fees and other charges] of the Local Government Act; and
 - c. revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.
- 8. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned for annual operating charges shall under Section 803 (1) (a) [Options for cost recovery] of the Local Government Act not exceed a levy of \$21,400 Dollars or (\$0.0038) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) on the net taxable value of land and improvements included in the service area whichever is greater.

WITHDRAWAL

9. A participant may withdraw from the function by giving at least 16 months notice in writing to the Board prior to September 1st of a given year thereby taking effect December 31st of the following year.
