BY-LAW NO. 1160

A by-law of the Regional District of North Okanagan to convert Supplementary Letters Patent outlining the function of Emergency Telephone Response Service to the Extended Service of 911 Emergency Telephone Response Service.

WHEREAS the Regional District of North Okanagan was issued the function of Division XLIV - Emergency Telephone Response Service by Supplementary Letters Patent dated February 24, 1988 with all member municipalities participating;

AND WHEREAS Section 767 (4) of the Municipal Act provides that the Regional District may convert a service established by Supplementary Letters Patent to one exercised under the authority of a by-law establishing the service;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 789(f.1) of the Municipal Act, the Regional District may establish and operate the Extended Service of Emergency Telephone Systems;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of North Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1.The function of Division XLIV Emergency Telephone Response Service established by Supplementary Letters Patent dated February 24, 1988 is hereby converted and established as the Extended Service of 911 Emergency Telephone System.
- 2.The service area for the Extended Service converted and established by Section 1 shall encompass and include the City of Armstrong, the District of Coldstream, the City of Enderby, the Village of Lumby, the Township of Spallumcheen, the City of Vernon, and Electoral Areas "A", "B", "C", "D", "E" and "F" ~~except~~ **including** that portion of Electoral Area "F" within the Salmon Arm Telephone Exchange as shown on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law. **(Bylaw No. 1662, 2000)**
- 3.The Regional District may carry out or cause to carry out the finance, installation, operation and maintenance of a 911 Emergency Telephone System within all or part of the participating member municipalities.
- 4.The costs for this service may be recovered by:
 - (a)revenues from the sale of goods and services;

(b)the requisition of money under Section 809 and 809.1 of the Municipal Act to be collected by a property value tax as provided in Section 810(1) and 810.1 of the said Act.

5.The annual net costs for this Service shall be apportioned among the participating areas on the basis of the current assessed values of land and improvements.

6.The amount that may be requisitioned for this service shall not exceed the product of a levy of \$0.30 per thousand dollars of assessed value of land and improvements within the service area.

7.The Regional District may provide the said service through its own resources or by entering into contractual agreements.

8.This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Regional District of North Okanagan 911 Extended Service Conversion and Establishment By-law No. 1160, 1993.

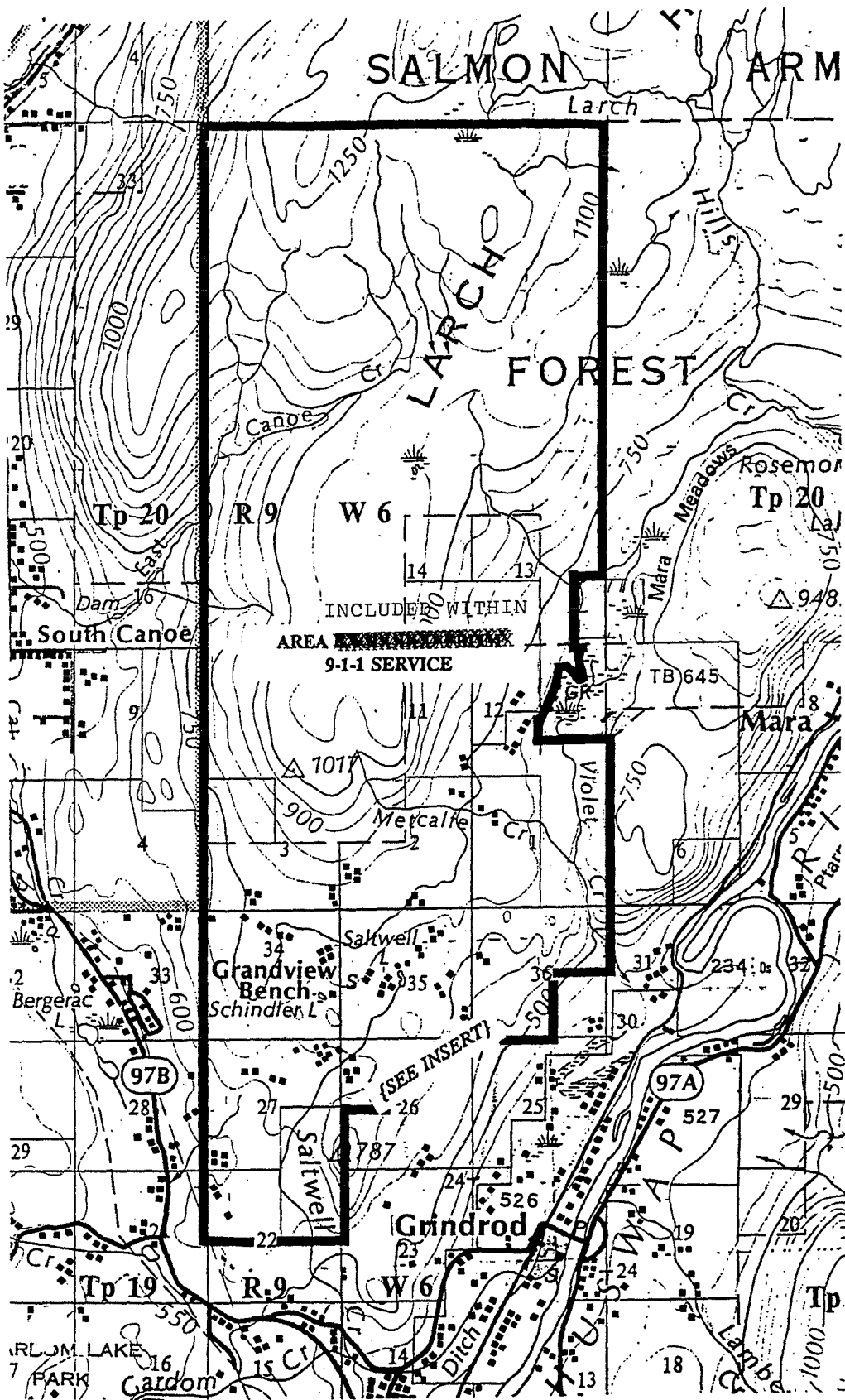
